School Fees

Stationery items

Snacks

- ❖ Snacks can be Cut Fruits - Orange, Guava, Chikoo, Cucumber, Fruit salad, Vegetable Raitha, Groundnut Burfi, Boiled/RoastedGroundnuts, Nuts, Raisins and Dates, Homemade sweets and savouries, varieties of Puttu, Sprout, Sundals made of Green Gram, Chana, Soya Bean, Groundnut, Horse gram, Wheat Bread Sandwich.
- ❖ Chocolate and cakes are not allowed.
- ❖ Noodles and deep-fried snacks are not allowed
- ❖ Lunch if brought can be curd rice/ sambar rice with lots of vegetables (all types) as a side dish. For children who are accustomed to eating on their own without messing up.
- ❖ Students must carry their own Lunch Box, Spoon, Water Bottle, Towel, Apron without fail.

Snacks bag and dress/ book bag

Please ensure you give two different bags - snacks bag and dress cum book bag - both marked with permanent marker pens to identify your child's bag. Also see to it that the snacks bag is cleaned and washed as often as possible to avoid ants and insects getting into the food. The problem gets

aggravated because the spilt food or unwashed bag spreads ants and insects to the bags of other children. Please ensure that all the garments are marked with the initials of your child' to ensure proper identification of their clothes.

Library books

Library books should be brought back to the school on the scheduled day, failing which students have to pay a fine. In case a book is lost, the book has to be only replaced or paid for it.

FEEDBACK

Development of children is like building a house, some days you will see visible development, some days it is not so visible – like the curing process of building. This does not mean that there is no development. Without that curing process, the building (learning process) will collapse.

There is no necessity to check with teachers on a daily basis. Never ask the child what they learnt when they reach home. Instead, after playing sometime with the child, ask the child to teach parents/ grandparents what he/she learnt. The child will react favourably

GENERAL RULES OF THE SCHOOL

ASSEMBLY

Assembly is an important activity of the school. All students have to attend and participate in it. They should maintain discipline throughout the proceeding of the assembly. Those who show disrespect or refuse to participate in the assembly will have to leave the school.

ATTENDANCE

Parents are requested to see that the child attends school every day. Whenever a student remains absent, parents have to write and send a leave note in the School diary. If he / she has to remain absent from school due to some extraordinary circumstance, the parents should meet the Principal and inform immediately. A student must have at least 80% attendance for promotion to the next class.

Half-day attendance is not allowed. Parents should not call their children home before the end of the school hours.

GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Discipline is an integral part of the school culture. The school encourages self-discipline that arises from within and remains throughout life. Some general rules of discipline to be followed are -

- Students are expected to maintain discipline within the school campus and in class.
- Students should be neatly dressed and enter the campus only in proper school uniform at all times unless instructed otherwise. Student ID card should be worn at all times while in school.

- Students should remain within the school campus during school hours and not venture out on any pretext. Adequate snacks and stationery should be brought.
- Students must keep their classes and surroundings clean and not litter.
- Mobile Phones, Cameras, Radios, Watches or any other gadgets are strictly prohibited inside the school premises. CD/Pen drive may be brought only if they have been asked by any teacher.
- Care must be taken of all school property and if any damage is done, it will be made good by the concerned student together with a fine imposed for the offence.
- Our students are expected to speak only in English right from the moment they enter the school premises and also inside school buses.
- Discipline and good behaviour should be maintained inside the school buses.
- Bullying is strictly not allowed and action will be taken if any case of bullying is observed.
- Students should not have parties in their classrooms or in the school premises.
- Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged. Parents are responsible to make up for the loss of the studies in case of leave taken. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that must be ensured by the parents only.

GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- In order to realise the highest ideal of education and to nurture the sterling qualities of an all rounded personality, the school solicits your co-operation.
- Parents are requested to work hand-in-hand with the school in its attempt to help their children progress, paying attention to their punctuality, regularity and discipline. They should take interest in their child's studies and other activities.
- Parents need to check the school diary/web portal every day and note the homework and other instructions given. They are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any circular/notice/invitation etc, has been issued.
- Parents should ensure that their children do not bring any valuables to school. They should also discourage buying and bringing of expensive items, including stationery and other items.
- Parents must first consult the school calendar, date sheets and other circulars, before making enquiries on the phone.
- Parents must provide the school with correct mobile numbers and also inform about the changes (if any) so that SMS containing important messages like attendance, marks, etc. can be sent to them.
- Parents are requested to inform the school if there is any change in their address and telephone numbers.
- Parents are requested not to enter classroom to see their children or teachers during school hours.
- The name, admn. no. class and section of the pupil should be clearly marked on all belongings of the child eg. Bag. School will not be responsible for lost materials.

- Students who habitually involve in cheating, theft, misbehaviour or misconduct, despite repeated warnings and constant efforts by the staff to improve their behaviour, will be reported.
- The school discourages absenteeism and parents should not allow the students to skip classes. In case of emergency only short leave may be given.
- Any kind of criticism of the school or teachers should be avoided in the presence of students.
- Parents are requested to maintain a folder of all result sheets/certificates given by the school.
